OUR ADOPTION PROCESS

We've built our adoption process so that the animals we invest in and care so deeply about get the loving homes they deserve. While our process might have a few more steps than a shelter, the best friend you will receive is well worth it!



Rescue

Friendly animals in need come our way, many have been abandoned by previous owners. Some have never had a loving home.



As a foster-based rescue, before we can commit to an animal we make sure we have a foster home in place. Foster homes are so important and SO needed. We're always looking for new foster homes for animals that come our way.

(♥) ♥ Vet Care

A trip to the vet is crucial for any new rescue animal. Animals are tested for lifethreatening illnesses, receive vaccinations, a physical exam and get spayed or neutered.

Meet and Greet

This is a chance for potential adopters to meet their future pet and ensure that this is a good fit. During COVID-19 we utilized a 30-day foster-to-adopt period where potential adopters can have some time with the animal before the adoption is final.



Home Visit

We take a trip to meet you and see the future home of an adoptable animal. We're not inspecting your housekeeping skills, just ensuring that the animal will have a safe and fulfilling place to live. During COVID-19 we utilized virtual visits.

Vet/Landlord Check

We do our due diligence to confirm with a veterinarian that any previous pets have been kept up to date on vet care. In addition, for renters we confirm with the landlord that this pet would be allowed.



Forever Home

An animal has officially been rescued and found their perfect home. Adopters sign an adoption agreement confirming that they will keep the animal safe, healthy and loved. Of course, we always love hearing about our adopted pets and their new life in their forever home.



Back in their foster home, animals recover from any veterinary care and learn about life in a home. A foster family gets to know the animal and shares what they learn with a new adopter.



Application

All potential adopters must complete an application. This helps us make sure each animal gets the perfect home. We ask for basic information about you, your home, your past pets/veterinarian and your understanding of what it means to care for a pet.
